1.1 PROJECT INFORMATION

- A. Notice to Bidders: Qualified bidders may submit bids for project as described in this Document. Submit bids according to the Instructions to Bidders.
 - 1. Regulatory Requirements: Applicable laws and regulation of those having jurisdiction in the State of Illinois shall govern submittal, opening, and award of bids.
 - 2. All Contracts for the Construction of Public Works are subject to the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130/1-12).

- E. Project Description: The Work consists of the replacement of the fire alarm panel and related components at Evelyn Alexander Elementary School, along with the associated electrical revisions and restoration of finishes affected as well as other Work indicated in the Contract Documents.
- F. Construction Contract: Single Prime Contract (all trades).

1.2 BID SUBMITTAL AND OPENING

- A. Owner will receive lump sum bids until the bid time and date at the location given below. The sealed bid must be submitted on the Bid Form provided, Project Name, Date, Time of Bid and "ATTN: Bryan Arnold" clearly marked on the outside of the sealed envelope to prevent premature opening. Owner will consider bids prepared in compliance with the Instructions to Bidders, and delivered as follows:

 - 2. Bid Time: 1:00 p.m., local time.
 - 3. Location: Administration Offices, 2000 Lewis Avenue, North Chicago, Illinois 60064
- B. Bidders will not be permitted to attend the bid opening in person; bidders may attend by video or telephone call in.

- C. Bids will be thereafter publicly opened and read aloud.
- D. Any bid submitted unsealed, or unsigned, without bid bond or received subsequent to the aforementioned date and hour will be disqualified and returned to the bidder.

- E. Owner reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities and irregularities.

1.3 BID SECURITY

- A. Bid Security is required in the form of a Bid Bond, AIA Document A310 in an amount equal to not less than ten percent (10%) of the Base Bid.
- B. It is the Owner's intent to issue a Notice of Award to the successful Bidder within thirty (30) calendar days of the Bid Date. No bid shall be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after the opening of bids.

- B. Bidders shall visit the site and familiarize themselves with the conditions under which the work is to be performed.

- B. The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond, in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract sum, on AIA Document A312, as issued by the American Institute of Architects.
